
How to Connect to the Burnaby SD Wireless Network

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The Burnaby School District wireless network is available to staff and students at all locations in the district. Anyone with an active network account can attach to the wireless network and use this service. This is the same account you use to log into a computer and to Microsoft Outlook.

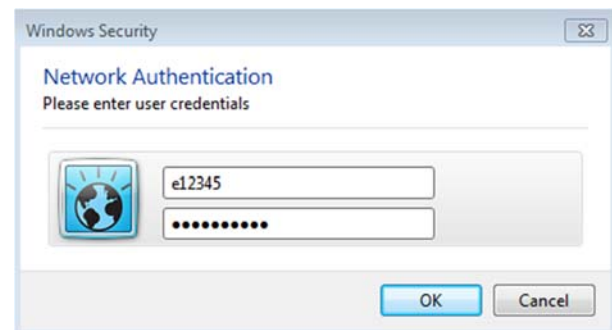
Connecting Your Windows Device to the Wireless Network

1. Click the wireless icon in the notification area located at the bottom right corner of the Taskbar.
2. Select the SD41 SSID and click the Connect button.



3. Enter your network account ID and password. This is the same account you use to log on your district computer and Outlook.

Click the OK button.



4. Verify that the wireless connection has been established.



Connecting Your Macintosh Device to the Wireless Network

1. Click the wireless icon in the menu bar and select SD41.



2. Enter your network account ID and password. This is the same account you use to log on your district computer and Outlook.

Click the OK button



3. Click the Continue button



4. Enter your computers local administrator account name and password, and then click Update Settings button.



5. Verify that the wireless connection has been established.

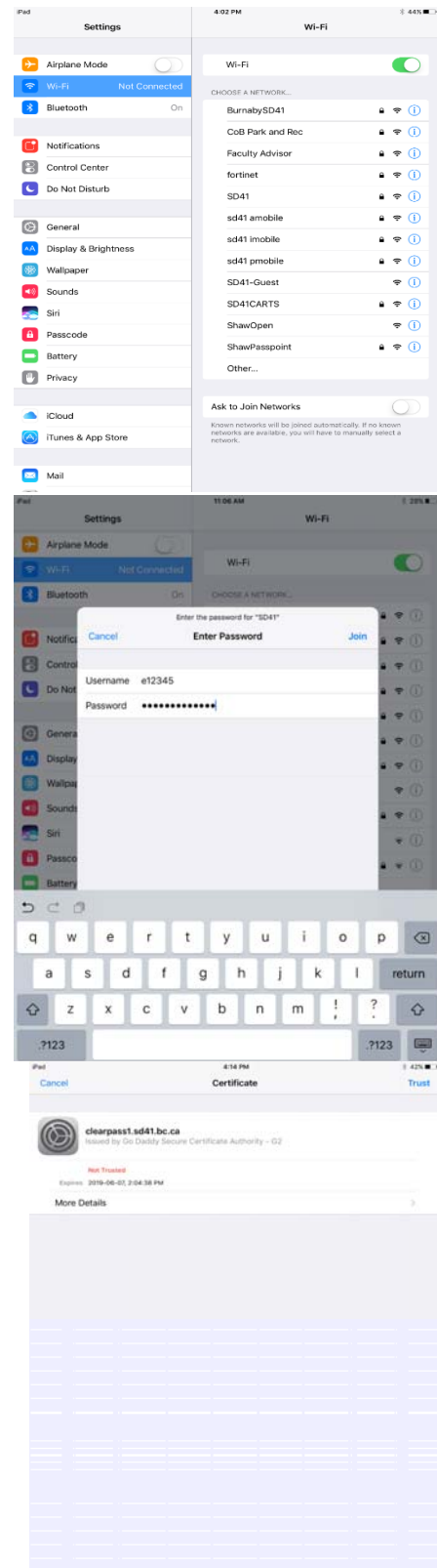


Connecting Your iOS Device to the Wireless Network

1. Go to Settings >> Wi-Fi and select SD41.
2. Enter your network account ID and password. This is the same account you use to log on your district computer and Outlook.

Click on Join.

3. Click on Trust.



4. Verify that the wireless connection has been established.



Connecting Your Android Device to the Wireless Network

Due to the various flavours of Android operating systems in use and differing manufacturers interfaces, please consider this information as a general guide. Follow the usual steps that you would use to establish other wireless connections.

1. Go to Settings >> Wi-Fi and select SD41.

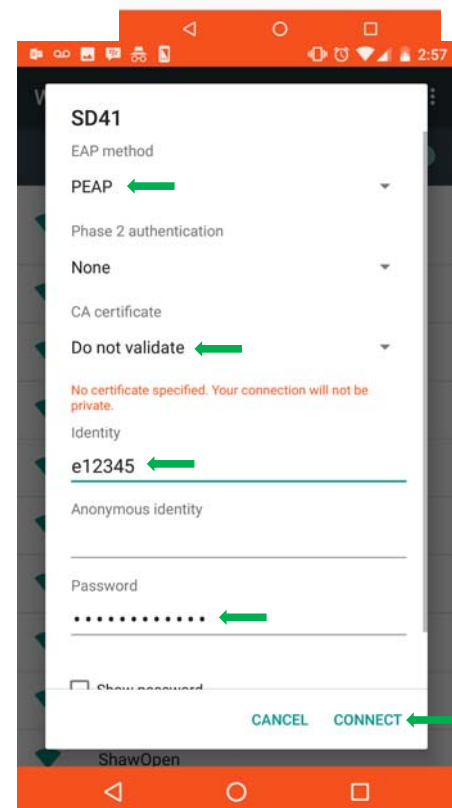


2. Select PEAP as EAP method.

Select Do not validate as CA certificate.

Enter your network account ID and password. This is the same account you use to log on your district computer and Outlook.

Click CONNECT button.



3. The wireless connection is established
